Healthy Homes Essentials for Environmental Professionals

This training is a condensed version of the Essentials course for accelerated training for those individuals who already have certification as a professional in a healthy home field of expertise. It complements hazard-specific training in lead-based paint, radon, mold, pests, and asbestos. It identifies root causes of health problems in a home and links them to seven principles of healthy housing. Course participants will have additional understanding of how to their current area(s) of expertise can be integrated with the healthy homes principles so they are better prepared to make healthy homes a reality in their communities.

Pre-requisite: To attend this course, you must have at least five years of experience in one of the following fields: indoor air quality management; indoor environmental consulting; indoor environmental remediation; industrial hygiene-hazard assessment; indoor environmental hazard control-restoration; mold assessment, consulting, investigation or remediation; water loss OR a credential or certification from one of these fields may be substituted for the five years of experience or the instructor, at his or her discretion, can let the student substitute an advanced degree.
