Past Performance

- **HUD's Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes:** Since FY 2004, \$12.7 million from three mission support IDIQ and other contracts for evaluations, research, training, policy guidance documents, and toolkits.
- **CDC's Healthy Homes and Lead Poisoning Prevention Branch** (now known as the Lead Poisoning Prevention Program): Since FY 2004, over \$8.2 million in revenue from sole-source contracts, multiyear mission support IDIQ contract task orders, and subcontracts for training, field research, and pilot projects.
- **State and city contracts:** Since FY 2004, a total of \$285,000 for strategic planning and training.
